

Public Notice

Per Resolution # 29-532-2018-05 the following Tribal Flag/Donation Policy has been drafted to regulate the manner in which tribal flags are provided to the public:

- 1. Enrolled Members of the Fort Peck Tribes who are currently serving overseas deployment are eligible for one free flag.**
- 2. Enrolled Fort Peck Tribal Member Veterans not currently serving in an overseas deployment flags will be available at the cost of \$50.00.**
- 3. Fort Peck Tribal Members who have a non-veteran status, flags will be available at the cost of \$100.00**
- 4. Non-enrolled members wishing to purchase a tribal flag will be \$150.00.**
- 5. All schools residing on the Fort Peck Reservation will be given one free tribal flag. If a replacement flag is needed, it will be at the cost of \$75.00 and the old flag must be returned.**
- 6. If a flag is borrowed for an event, there will be a \$50.00 deposit. Once the flag is returned in the condition it was taken, the deposit will be given back.**

This policy will remain in place until amended by official action of the Fort Peck Tribal Executive Board. Dated May 14, 2018 at a Special Meeting by the affirmative vote of 10 for and 2 absent. (see attached resolution)



RESOLUTION #29-532-2018-05

TRIBAL GOVERNMENT
Veterans, Elders, & Youth

WHEREAS, the Fort Peck Tribal Executive Board is the duly elected body representing the Assiniboine and Sioux Tribes of the Fort Peck Reservation and is empowered to act on behalf of the Tribes. All actions shall be adherent to provisions set forth in the 1960 Constitution and By-Laws, and

WHEREAS, the following Tribal flag sale/donation policy has been drafted to regulate the manner in which Tribal flags are provided to the public:

- (1) Enrolled Members of the Fort Peck Tribes who are currently serving overseas deployment, are eligible for one free flag;
- (2) Enrolled Fort Peck tribal member veterans not currently serving in an overseas deployment flags will be available at the cost of \$50;
- (3) Fort Peck tribal members who have a non-veteran status, flags will be available at the cost of \$100;
- (4) Non-enrolled members wishing to purchase a tribal flag will be \$150;
- (5) All schools residing on the Fort Peck Reservation will be given one free tribal flag. If a replacement flag is needed, it will be at the cost of \$75.00, and the old flag must be returned;
- (6) If a flag is borrowed for an event, there will be a \$50.00 deposit. Once the flag is returned in the condition it was taken, the deposit will be given back.

WHEREAS, the policy will remain in place until amended by official action of the Tribal Executive Board, now


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Fort Peck Tribal Executive Board hereby approve the Tribal Flag Sale/Donation Policy.
